He also was a member of the Aladdin Shrine in Columbus, Ohio, the Steubenville Shrine Club, served on the board of the Shrine Erie Hospital and the Royal Order of Jester. He and Jackie, his wife, were members of LaBelle Chapter #414 O.E.S. and several other affiliated Masonic bodies. Ill. Ken Gorney joined the Valley of Steubenville on April 26, 1980. He served the Valley as the Sovereign Prince of Cutler Council, Princes of Jerusalem in 2007 and Commander-in-Chief of Jefferson Consistory, S.P.R.S. in 2013. He was the Chairman of Family Life, director of the 10th, 15th, and 26th degrees, member and vice chairman of the Executive Committee, participated in numerous degrees and was the go to man for anything that needed done. He was honored with the Valley Service Award (VSA) in 2006, the recipient of the Meritorious Service Award (MSA) in 2009 in Dayton, Ohio and the "Spirit of the Valley Award" in May 2016. On August 28, 2013 in Washington, D.C. he was Coroneted a Sovereign Grand Inspector General, 33°, and an honorary member of the Supreme Council of the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction of the United States of America, the 120th member of the Valley of Steubenville to receive this honor.





Just a short note about what the Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite to help the victims of hurricane Irma in Florida. Our Sovereign Grand Commander Illustrious David A. Glattly, 33° has requested that each Valley Secretary contact the Brothers of their Valley living in Florida. The Scottish Rite receiving some assistance shortly.— Valley of Steubenville has 40 members currently living in Florida. So far III. Edsel Emery, 33° and myself have contacted 40 families. Of the 40 we have spoke to 25. We have found out that 3 brothers have passed away, 5 brothers need assistance, 17 are ok, and 15 their phones are still disconnected. The three that had passed away was not due to the hurricane the office wasn't notified of their passing.

The stories are very heartwarming and moving. One gentleman that is 92 years old, lost power for 5 days and lost all his food. You could hear in his voice that he was worried and scared. Most had water damage. Another fellow had damage to his house, motor home, and property. He is 78 years old.

Another brother is disabled and needs a new roof. The insurance company does not cover roofs in the area he lives.

These are a few of the stories from our Florida brothers. Please keep them and their families in your prayers. You should be very proud of the fraternity you belong to, that we do not neglect our brothers in need even when they are out of the area. All the names have been sent to Supreme and they will be O.
